RESOLUTION FINDING ENDRESS & HAUSER IN DEFAULT OF RESOLUTION NO. 5709 ENTERED INTO ON JULY 19, 2023 FOR URCHASE OF GAS METERS AND AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO SEEK REDRESS FOR DAMAGES AND CONSEQUENTAIL DAMAGES AND TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A NEW CONTRACT FOR REPLACEMENT METERS

WHEREAS, the Township of Neptune Sewerage Authority "TNSA" passed Resolution No. 5709 on July 19, 2023 authorizing the purchase of gas meters from Endress & Hauser through the North Jersey Wastewater Cooperative Pricing System under Contract Number B343-5 for a total of \$38,622.00; and

WHEREAS, the order has not been completed, and as of this date the delivered meters are not fully operational and have not been certified; and

WHEREAS, TNSA has incurred electrical charges associated with the malfunctioning meters; and

WHEREAS, TNSA may incur additional costs for the purchase of the replacement meters; and

WHEREAS, the meters are vital to the safe operations of the TNSA Wastewater Treatment Plant; and

WHEREAS, the North Jersey Wastewater Cooperative Pricing System Contract No. B343-5, Specifications, General Conditions Section (u) "Default" provides for the Commissioners to hold the vendor in default, purchase materials and seek costs including the difference in contract price.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that TNSA has found Endress & Hauser in default of their contract and has authorized the Executive Director to enter into a new contract for replacement gas meters and seek damages and consequential damages as result of the default of contract.
