Based upon the extremely low concentration levels of each identified constituent coupled with the expected low discharge flow of the groundwater of 10 gallons per minute on a continuous basis, the loading of each constituent into the Authority's wastewater treatment plant will not have an impact on the plant's ability to effectively and efficiently treat wastewater;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED to authorize Coast Cities a onetime temporary discharge of approximately 200,000 gallons of decontaminated groundwater into the Authority's wastewater treatment plant based upon the recommendation of the Authority's Engineer Richard Crane of T&M Associates.
