TNSA Resolution No. 4981

RESOLUTION ADOPTING UPDATED PERSONNEL MANUAL FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF NEPTUNE SEWERAGE AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, it is the policy of Township of Neptune Sewerage Authority to treat employees and prospective employees in a manner consistent with all applicable employment laws and regulations including, but not limited to Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended by the Equal Opportunity Act of 1972, the Age Discrimination in Employment Act, the Equal Pay for Equal Work Act, the Fair Labor Standards Act, the New Jersey Law Against Discrimination, the Americans with Disabilities Act, the Family and Medical Leave Act, the Conscientious Employee Protection Act, the New Jersey Workers Compensation Act, and the Federal Consolidated Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act (COBRA); and

WHEREAS, the Township of Neptune Sewerage Authority has determined that there is a need for general updates and revisions to TNSA's Personnel Manual to ensure that employees and prospective employees are treated in a manner consistent with these laws and regulations, as well as to promote consistency, continuity and understanding within the organization.

NOW, THEREBY, BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of the Township of Neptune Sewerage Authority that the Personnel Manual attached hereto is hereby adopted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Personnel Manual shall apply to all Township of Neptune Sewerage Authority officials, appointees, employees, volunteers and independent contractors. In the event there is a conflict between these rules and any collective bargaining agreement, personnel services contract or Federal or State law, the terms and conditions of that contract or law shall prevail. In all other cases, this Personnel Manual shall prevail.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Personnel Manual is intended to provide guidelines covering public service by Township of Neptune Sewerage Authority employees and is not a contract. The provisions of this Personnel Manual may be amended and supplemented from time to time without notice and at the sole discretion of the Township of Neptune Sewerage Authority.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that to the maximum extent permitted by law, employment practices for the Township of Neptune Sewerage Authority shall operate under the legal doctrine known as "employment at will".

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Executive Director and all managerial/supervisory personnel are responsible for these employment practices. The Labor Attorney shall assist the Executive Director in the implementation of the policies and procedures in this Personnel Manual.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the governing body of the Township of Neptune Sewerage Authority that the attached revised and updated Personnel Manual be adopted on December 14, 2016.
