WHEREAS, the Authority's Engineer John Van Dorpe of Maser Consulting has determined that the current situation with the deteriorated, failing equipment at the TNSA WWTP Train 3 Headworks constitutes an emergency condition; and

WHEREAS, the equipment serving one of the two grit removal chambers for Train 3 had been compromised and was out of service. As a result, spare parts from that equipment have been used to maintain the remaining grit collection and removal equipment serving Train 3. With only antiquated failing equipment in one chamber operational and to avoid major problems, which could detrimentally affect the downstream treatment process and equipment, the Authority's Engineer John Van Dorpe recommended expedient replacement of the existing mechanical components serving the Train 3 grit removal system; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended to requisition replacement in-kind with the original Envirodyne equipment to minimize the time and effort required to design, furnish and install the new equipment;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Neptune Sewerage Authority hereby declare that an emergency condition exists due to the deterioration of the Train 3 Headworks constituting the necessity for replacement in-kind with the original Envirodyne equipment to minimize the time and effort required to design, furnish and install the new equipment.
