**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ADOPTION OF
THE 2026 SERVICE CHARGES**

WHEREAS, the Township of Neptune Sewerage Authority (“TNSA”) desires to review its Schedule of Service Charges for the year ending December 31, 2026; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Sewerage Authority Law N.J.S.A. 40:14A-1 et seq. a public hearing was conducted on March 18, 2026 for the purpose of considering the adoption of the proposed Schedule of Service Charges for the year ending December 31, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the notice of the proposed hearing was mailed to the Business Administrators of each Municipality served by the Authority and published in the Authority’s official newspapers; and

WHEREAS, at the rate hearing, the Authority presented evidence concerning the circulation of the proposed Schedule of Service Charges pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:14A-8; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the requirements of N.J.S.A. 40:14-8, it was determined that the Schedule of Service Charges for the year ending December 31, 2026 should be as follows:

**RESOLUTION APPROVING A THREE YEAR MAINTENCE CONTRACT
WITH STEWART & STEVENSON POWER PRODUCTS LLC FOR
GENERATORS AND DIESEL PUMP REPAIR SERVICES**

Whereas, the Township of Neptune Sewerage Authority (“TNSA”) has determined a need to enter into an three year Agreement for Generator Equipment and Maintenance Service with Stewart & Stevenson Power Products LLC; and

Whereas, Stewart & Stevenson Power Products LLC, 180 Route 17 South, Lodi, NJ 07644 has been awarded the Cooperative Pricing System under MCESCNJ Cooperative Pricing System for Generator Equipment and Maintenance Bid No. ESCNJ #65MCESCCPS; and

Whereas, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-11(5) authorizes contracting units to establish a Cooperative Pricing System and to enter into Cooperative Pricing Agreements for its administration; and

Whereas, TNSA entered into the Monmouth-Ocean Educational Services Commission (MOESC) on September 17, 2025; and

Whereas, TNSA obtained a three year Service Agreement from Stewart & Stevenson Power Products LLC for a total amount of \$90,393.00; and

Whereas, the Authority’s Certification of Funds is attached and made part of this resolution; and

Now, therefore, be it resolved the Township of Neptune Sewerage Authority, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, hereby directs the Executive Director to execute a three year Service Agreement with Stewart & Stevenson Power Products LLC for Generator Equipment and Maintenance Services utilizing the MCESCNJ Cooperating Pricing System Contract No. 65MCESCCPS.

ADDITIONAL NEW AIR RELEASE VALVES**



2026 PROFESSIONAL AGREEMENTS**


WHEREAS, the Township of Neptune Sewerage Authority (“Authority”) appointed the following professionals for a one year term:
