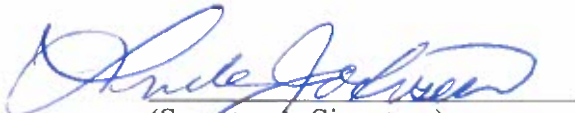

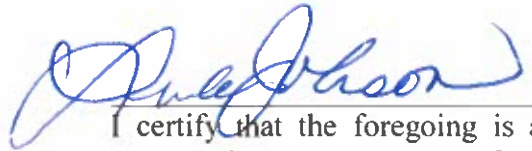

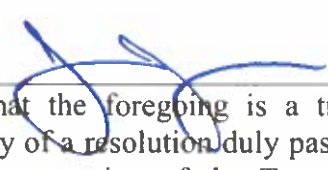

TO FREEOLD CARTAGE, INC. FOR THE 2027 CALENDAR YEAR**

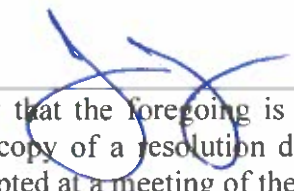

THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION**

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, Air Energy and Materials Sustainability Division of Air Enforcement issued a Pollution Control Preconstruction Permit and Certificate to Operate to The Township of Neptune Sewage Authority ("TNSA"); and

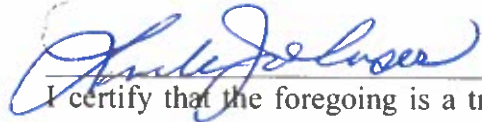
WHEREAS, the Permit sets forth specific parameters to be monitored and reported; and

WHEREAS, the Authority failed to fulfill all conditions and provisions of PCP230002, U1, OS Summary, Reference #2 by exceeding the permitted H2S limit during quarterly sampling on June 26, 2025, September 19, 2025 and June 9, 2026;

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, Air Energy and Materials Sustainability Division of Air Enforcement and the Authority reached a Settlement Agreement imposing a fine of \$9,600.00 for the above exceedances;

WHEREAS, the Authority's Executive Director has certified that funds are available for this purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township of Neptune Sewerage Authority to authorize the execution of the Settlement Agreement and payment to the State of New Jersey, Treasurer in the amount of \$6,400.00 for the above stated exceedances.
